



# Comprehensive Community Plan: Public Engagement Home Activity

## Introduction

### Project Background

In February 2018, we began creating the Comprehensive Community Plan (CCP). The CCP is the most important long-term planning document that will help guide the Nation in decision-making on Reserve and establish a clear vision with supported actions for Kitselas First Nation.

Community input has guided the development of a vision, mission and goals for the CCP. We are now moving forward with the next phase of planning. Community input is being sought to develop and finalize the supporting actions to help us focus on priorities and support Plan implementation.

### Activity Purpose

This activity will focus on understanding what actions are most important to our Members and the community. The input collected will help us to develop the list of actions included in the Plan and understand what priorities our Members have.

### Before You Start

Before getting started, take a few minutes to:

- Set up a space in your dining or living room where you can all comfortably sit around and work on the activity questions.
- Grab enough pens and markers for everyone to be able to write their own answers.
- Organize the worksheets and activity materials included, so they are easy to work through.

### Materials

Your activity kit should include the following worksheets and materials:

- CCP Vision & Mission (1 page)
- Worksheets A1 & A2 Reviewing Suggested Actions (2 pages)
- Worksheet B (1 page)



# Activity Instructions

## 1. Review & Discuss

Worksheets A1 & A2

**We've been listening.** The content of the CCP has been developed with member input, using seven core topic areas. We are now in the process of developing a set of actions for each core topic. Community input has already helped us to gather a list of possible actions to include in the CCP.

As a group, use **Worksheet Sheet A1 & A2** to review the list of possible CCP actions by topic area. After reviewing each topic list, discuss with each other about:

- **What changes would you make to possible actions included in the list?**
- **What potential actions are missing from the core topic action list?**

Add notes on the Worksheets to share your groups' ideas and thoughts about the list of potential action items. Please do your best to print clearly so that ideas are clear.

Example: *'Create a walking trail for Elders on Gitaus'* is better than: *'Elder's walking trail'*





## 2. Create Your Own Set of Priorities

### Worksheet B - Part 1

**Actions help us achieve our vision and mission.** Now that you have reviewed and discussed potential action items by topic area, you get to create a set of actions that are important to your group or family.

We want to hear from the community what is important to you. We know there are lots of views and interests to consider. Discuss as a group what actions are most important to you and consider:

- The CCP Vision and Mission included as an illustration;
- Your own values, interests, and views for the future of Kitselas;
- Actions could be implemented in the next few years that would have a positive impact on helping you and our community thrive.

Use **Worksheet B - Part 1** to develop a set of **5 - 10 actions** that represent your group or family. There are a lot of aspects that contribute to community building, focus your action list on what is most important to your group or family.

## 3. Spending Priorities

### Worksheet B - Part 2

Now that you have developed your own list of actions based on your needs, desires and interests, we want you to develop a “budget” for your action list.

Imagine you are given a budget of \$100 to divide up between each action item in your list based on priority and need. As a group, consider:

- How much of the budget should be assigned to each action?
- Do certain actions require more funding than others? If so, which ones?

Using the Part 2 columns on **Worksheet B**, assign each action in your list with their budget amount based on your discussion. Together, they should total \$100.

*Example:*

Action #	Budget
Action #1	\$20
Action #2	\$10
Action #3	\$5
Action #4	\$45
Action #5	\$30
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$100</b>
