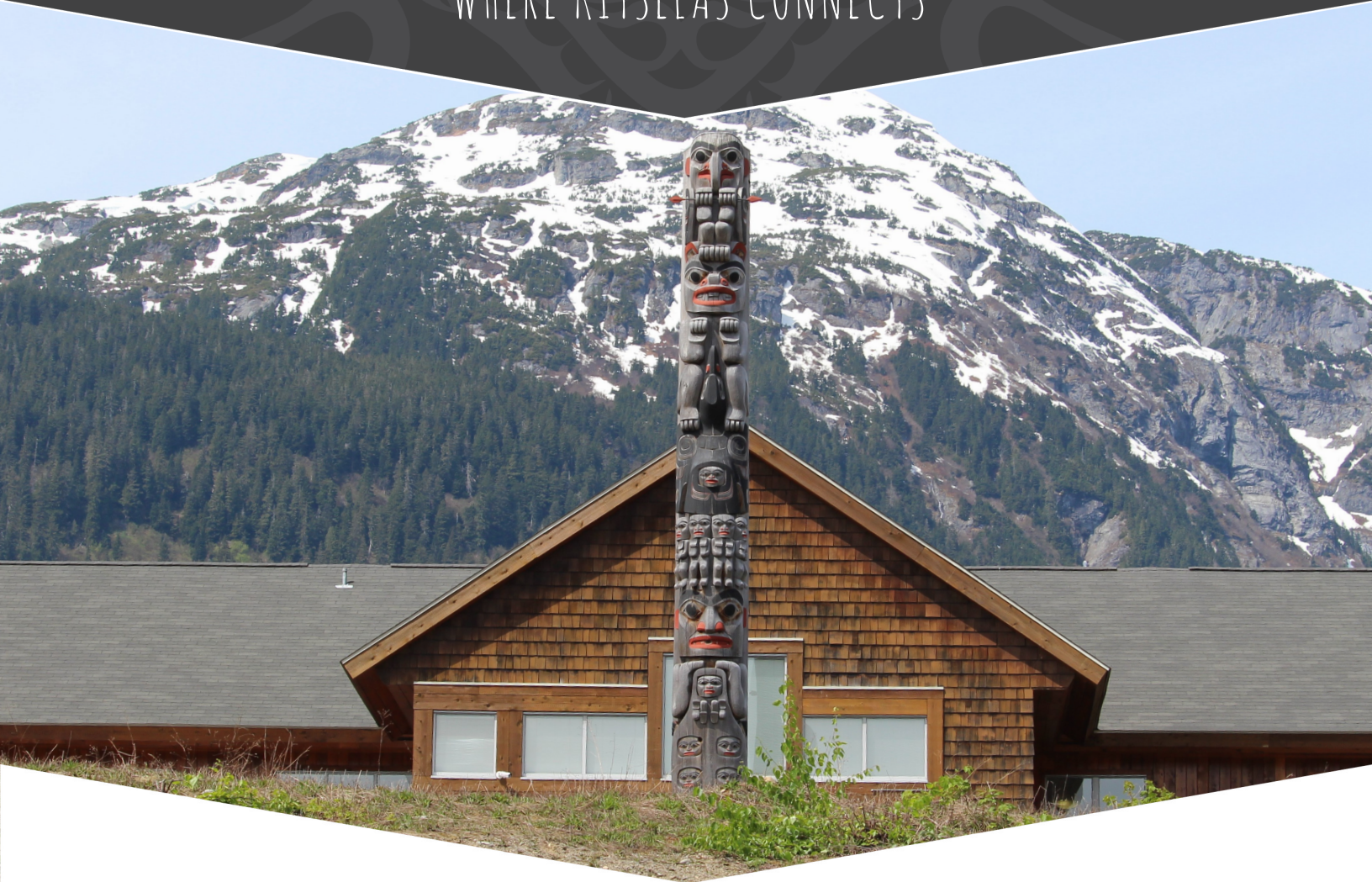

Both Kitselas Youth and Thornhill Fire Department offered activities like an Obstacle race, ring toss, zip line, bean bag toss, few relay races.

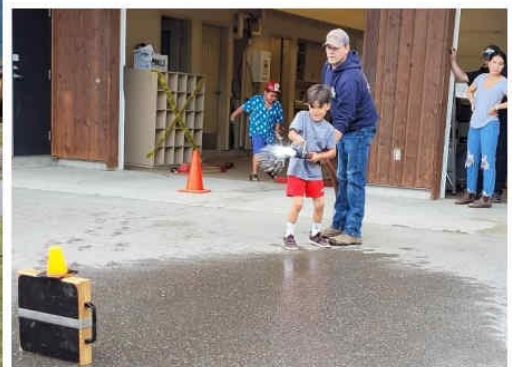

For making this a successful day.

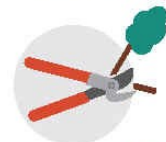

Move firewood 10 metres from your home.

Keep the gutters on the edge of the roof clean.

Use construction materials that won't catch fire easily.

Keep grass shorter than 10 centimetres.

Prune tree branches within 2 metres of the ground.

Use plants that won't catch fire easily.

Keep your yard free of branches, leaves and other things that can burn.

Remove branches that hang over the roof.
