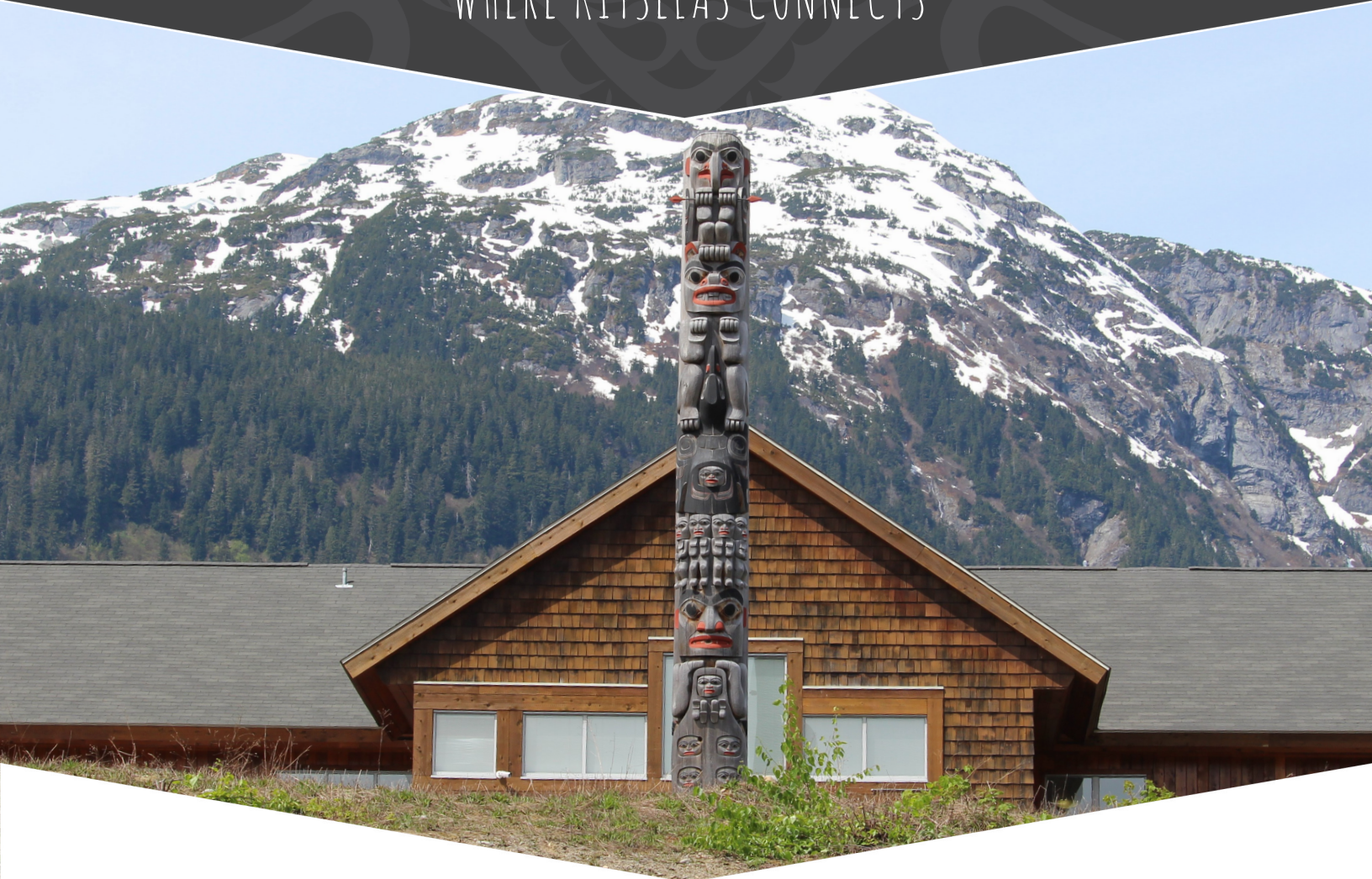

The Kitselas Treaty Department is seeking community members for the Treaty Land Use Plan Committee to assist in the development of a plan for Treaty Settlement Lands. This plan will build on the work complete on the On-Reserve Land Plan, available on the Kitselas First Nation website.

Committee membership

The Kitselas Treaty department is seeking 2 Kitselas members to represent:

- Elders and knowledge keepers
- On reserve Kitselas members
- Off reserve Kitselas members

Responsibilities

1. Prepare for meetings by reviewing all materials prior to meetings.
2. Attend an estimated THREE (3) scheduled meetings - Zoom will be available for meetings
3. Provide feedback and advice to the Director and fully participate in discussions of matters related to Kitselas potential Treaty Settlement Lands.
4. Review and comment on materials circulated via email or mail as per applicable forms and documentation provided by the Director or delegate.

Selection Criteria:

A person may make application to the Director for membership on the Committee if they possess the following qualifications:

- a) An interest in understanding land use planning, development and management as it pertains to Kitselas Potential Treaty Settlement Lands;
- b) Willingness to learn and understand land use planning principals;
- c) Familiarity with the Kitselas (On Reserve) Land Use Plan (available on KFN website);
- d) Available time to prepare and attend Committee meetings; and
- e) Knowledge of Kitselas culture and traditional land use.

Please respond with a summary of how you meet the above qualifications, as well as contact information.

Applications will be accepted from Oct 29, 2021 to November 12, 2021. The successful candidate will be notified on or before November 19th 2021.

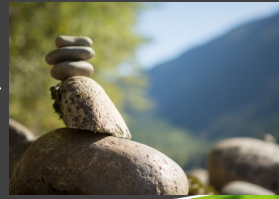
