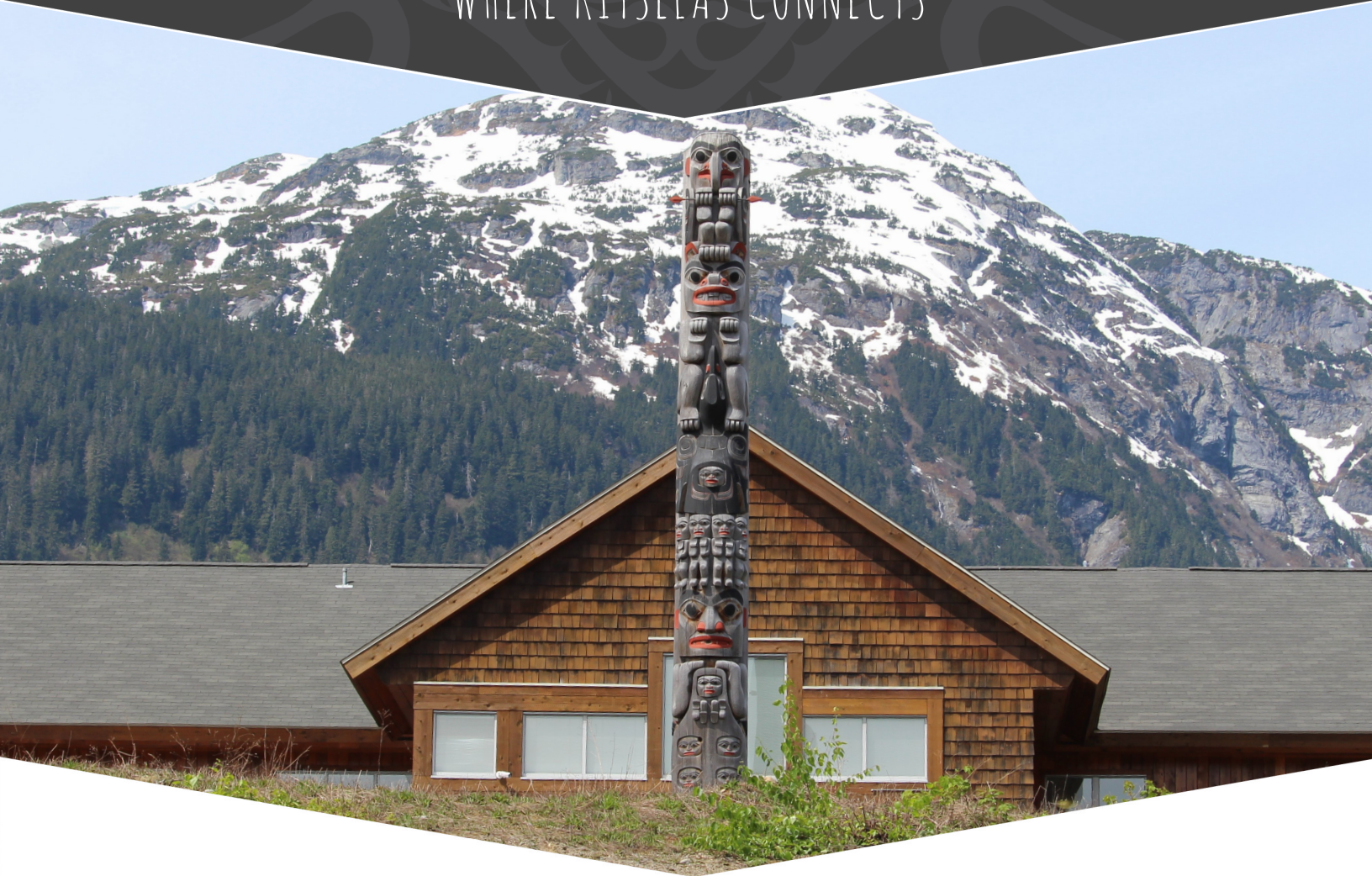

## Kitselas Culture Camp 2022

### Parent\Guardian Waiver.

- Every effort for care and attention will be given to the well-being and safety of participants.

- Program staff can not be held responsible for any accidents that may occur. In consideration of the Kitselas youth programs accepting the application.

### Kitselas Terms and Conditions of the Kitselas Youth Programs.

#### Ground Rules:

1. No Physical Contact. This includes: Hitting, Punching, Wrestling, Kicking, ETC.
  2. No verbal fighting. This includes swearing, name calling, teasing.
  3. Listen to Staff\Volunteers at all times.
  4. No Bullying. This includes no spitting, teasing, physical or verbal violence, name calling or sexual comments or behavior.
  5. No gossiping
  6. respect the personal space & property of others.
  7. Clean up after yourselves (garbage to bins, clean spills, put supplies back where they belong)
- Covid: we will supply hand cleaning stations\ Hand sanitizer & No attending if you or anyone in home is feeling unwell.

- Kitselas Youth Programs are a **NO TOLERANCE ZONE FOR DRUGS, ALCOHOL, CIGARETTES, VAPES AND WEAPONS**
- **Medical Emergency:** In the event of an emergency, the Kitselas staff may administrate the use of First-Aid treatment if necessary, and in case of medical emergency, permission is granted to the physician selected by supervisors to hospitalize and secure proper treatment for your child(ren) named on registration form. Every effort will be made to contact Parents or Guardians before such action. Kitselas staff also reserve the right to call for an ambulance if deemed necessary. You also acknowledge that you must assume total responsibility for ALL medical coverage, accidental insurance and personal injury, or any other loss or damage.

### Program Closures

- When youth are in a program they are supervised by staff and volunteers however, we cannot hold youth against their will, so in the event they choose to leave our programs and or property we cannot be held liable.
- Staff will encourage youth to inform parents that they are leaving the program and property
- Youth are required to Sign in and out for emergency reasons.
- Kitselas reserves the right to close programs due to unforeseen circumstances which may include but not limited to; staff shortage, emergency situations or inclement weather. incase of closure, staff will make an announcement .

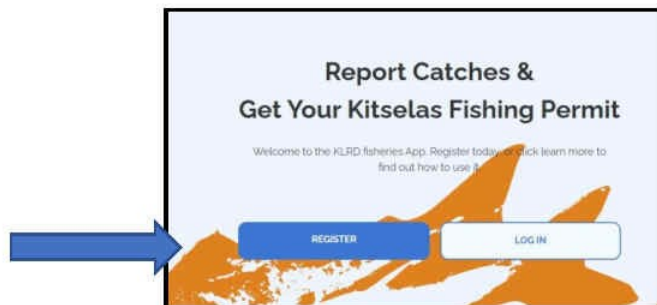


## Kitselas Fisheries App Directions

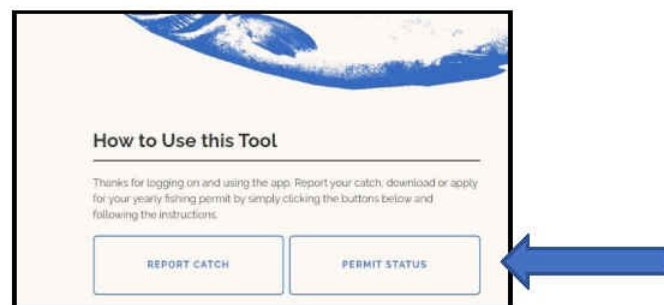
1. Scan QR Code or go to [fish.kitselas.com](https://fish.kitselas.com) – to scan point phone camera at code



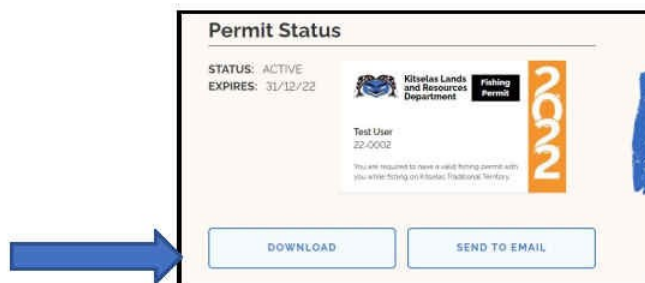
2. Register on the app – band membership number is needed to do this
