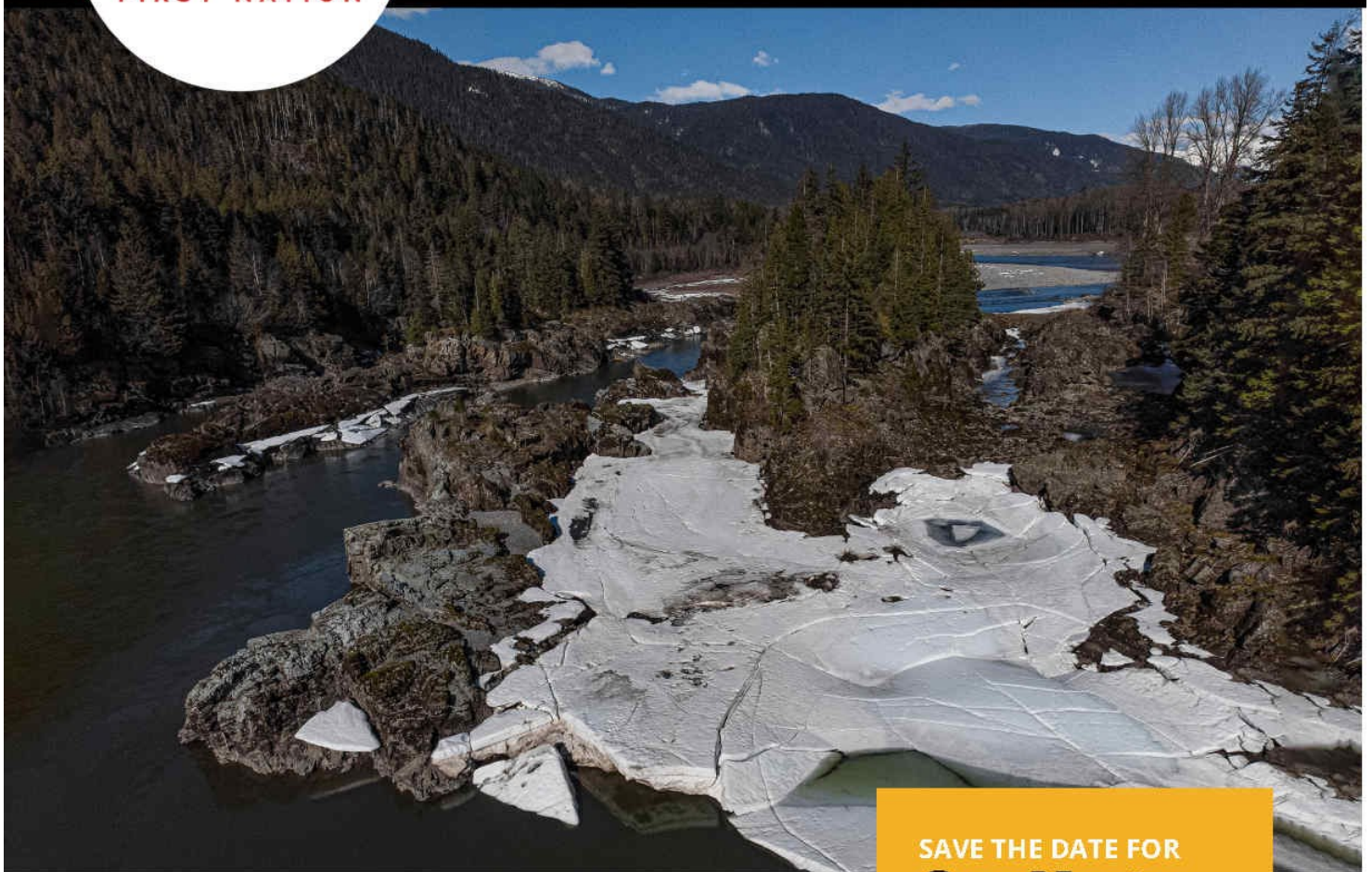

TOXIC DRUG ALERT



for Prince George, BC

Alert expires: January 20, 2023



Drug's characteristics

SUBSTANCE(S):

The substances are being smoked or injected and have caused sudden severe overdose and increased sedation. Multiple doses of naloxone are needed.

RESPONSES:



Sudden overdose.



Heavy and prolonged sedation.

Overdose signs



Slow or
NO breathing



Lips are blue



Nails are blue



Choking, gurgling, or
snoring sounds



Person is not moving
Can't be woken up



Skin feels cold
or clammy



Pupils are tiny

Have a Safety Plan

- Don't use alone

- When possible avoid mixing drugs or mixing drugs with alcohol
- Carry and know how to use naloxone
- **Call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number right away if someone overdoses**

There has been an increase in sudden overdose events in the community of Prince George. The substances consumed are causing prolonged sedation, requiring multiple doses of naloxone to reverse. Overdoses are occurring when substance are smoked or injected. **Substances move throughout our region and may present in your community so please share this alert widely and use with caution following the harm reduction messages.**
