NOTICE OF NOMINATION MEETING

Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the electors of the Kitselas First Nation will be held in the GITAUS ADMIN/HEALTH BUILDING ON APRIL 30, 2023, BEGINNING AT 6:00 PM AND LASTING FOR AT LEAST 3 HOURS, for the purpose of nominating one (1) candidate for the Office of Chief and seven (7) candidates for the Office of Councillor for the next ensuing term.

The ELECTION will take place on JUNE 12, 2023, from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM to be held at two locations:

- GITAUS ADMIN/HEALTH BUILDING, KITSELAS FIRST NATION
- KULSPAI KITSELAS COMMUNITY HALL, KITSELAS FIRST NATION

Please note that any voter may nominate candidates by using a mail-in nomination form. You can either deliver or mail-in a written nomination and a completed, signed and witnessed voter declaration form to the Electoral Officer before the time set out for the nomination meeting OR you may nominate candidates orally at the nomination meeting. Mailed nominations not received by the Electoral Officer before the time set for the nomination meeting are void.

Also note that any voter may vote by mail-in ballot.

Reporting to the Kitselas Council, the Senior Administrative Director (SAD) is the most senior position within Kitselas Band Administration, as defined in the Kitselas Committee to Council Act (2010), with duties divided into two key overlapping areas:

- First, the Senior Administrator is responsible for supporting elected leadership of the Nation, through providing administrative services to Kitselas Chief and Council.
- · Second, the Senior Administrator leads, manages and oversees all aspects of effective Band administrative and program delivery for Band Members, including authority for leading planning, organization, implementation and overall management of all Kitselas' day-to-day operations.

Required Qualifications - Minimum of 5 years' experience in a senior management position, University degree in related field, ability to deal professionally with the public, experience working in a First Nation band or entity.
