

Community Liaison to Work with Elections BC

Elections BC would like to put out an "expression of interest" to see who in the Kitselas Nation would be interested in the role of Community Liaison. This role is a contract position, paying up to 47 hours at \$21. per hour. The hope is that the community liaison will also become one of the election officials as well. The following are a list of some of the responsibilities of this position:

- * Be the contact person between the community and the Skeena riding electoral staff, beginning approximately May 1st.
- * Provide assistance in identifying and providing layout information of the voting place itself (where the voting stations will be, where the ballot officer tables will be, how the flow will be, wheelchair access, etc.)
- * Will help with voter registration drives and assist those community members who have not yet had the opportunity to register to vote. There are several ways that this can be done, either through online registration assistance, telephone registration, form completion registration or in person registrations in we will Kitimat. Training and support will be available.
- * Identify any specific community needs that are important for Elections BC to be aware of.
- * Help to identify community members as Election Officials for the October event.
