To Kitselas Members,

We want to update you on some important developments regarding community safety.

Due to recent incidents in Gitaus, Kitselas is in the process of installing security cameras throughout both Gitaus and Kulspai. Our top priority is ensuring the safety and well-being of all our members. These cameras will provide valuable footage, if needed, in situations involving security and safety concerns. Together, we must take proactive steps to protect each other and keep our communities safe.

There have also been concerns raised regarding the no-tolerance policy on drugs and illegal activity, particularly following the "seizure of suspected drugs" in late December. We want to reassure you that the investigation is ongoing, and charges have not been laid at this time. The RCMP is handling the process, and we are in regular communication with them. We are also seeking legal advice on additional measures we can take to further ensure safety within our communities.

Our commitment is to foster a healthy and supportive environment for all members. We want to remind everyone that addiction is a disease, and we are here to assist those who may be struggling. If you or a family member are in need of support, we encourage you to reach out to our Health Department for assistance.
